What is a Zoning Text Amendment?

A text amendment is a procedure that changes the written provisions of the zoning ordinances contained in the zoning code. From time to time, provisions of the zoning code may need to be updated or changed in order to better serve the needs of the town and its citizens. In those cases, the text of the zoning code may need to be changed, deleted or revised. In most cases, the Town is the initiator of this process but occasionally a residential, institutional or commercial applicant initiates the process for the change in the text to the zoning code. The end result of the process is for the Town Council to pass an ordinance amending the text of the zoning code. The ordinance concerning the amendment process is set forth in Article VIII, Section 21.69 of the Town of Santee Zoning Code.

What is a Zoning Map Amendment? (Rezoning)

A map amendment is a procedure that changes the zoning district for a piece of property and therefore changes the zoning map. Amendments to the designation of and/or location of district boundaries illustrated on the official zoning map shall be referred to as "map amendments" (also referred to as "rezoning"). In most cases the town is the initiator of this process but occasionally a residential, institutional or commercial applicant initiates the process for the change to the zoning map. The end result of the process is for the Town Council to pass an ordinance amending the zoning map. The ordinance concerning the amendment procedure is set forth in Article VIII, Section 21.69 of the Town of Santee Zoning Code.
